For us as a school community this inspection makes clear our achievements but the inspectors recommendations give us clear indications of what we need do to make Saint Mary's the outstanding school it can be so that every child at our school achieves their full potential.

This inspection becomes our new beginning. A strong and positive baseline from which to grow the school. This work has already begun and we ask you for your support and prayers as we move the school forward.

The governors would also like to bring you up to date regarding the Reception intake for September 2012.

You may be aware of the year on year difficulties,

because of increasing admission numbers, the Local Authority has faced in placing children in reception classes across the borough. This year is no different and the Local Authority has been looking to place an extra 19 reception classes throughout the borough.

We are very clear of the duty of care we have for those children near to our school who are in need of a school place. We also take seriously our responsibilities within the Diocese and the Local Authority as one of the family of primary schools.

As a result the governors have agreed to accept a bulge reception class, taking 60 pupils rather than our normal 30.

We fully understand the implications of this especially with a previous bulge class still moving through the school. Rest assured we are already working with Mr Marsh to secure the class

space, staff and facilities needed to serve this extra class.

We can at least be certain that all the new children and their families will be given a warm welcome into our school community.

And finally as a follow up to our last newsletter. A cooking kitchen at the school seems unlikely at the moment because of funding implications. We can report however that having made clear our concerns about the quality of food at the school to the catering company a new cook has been employed and the service and quality of the food has since improved considerably.
