# Future ideas of where future PTA funds will go

We met with Mr Marsh and discussed his vision for the school over the next few years. With our help, he is keen to create a wonderful and inviting environment for all the children to enjoy in the playground with the addition of a forest school and seating area, learning pod and a Shepherd's hut. With every event we do and the money we raise this will bring us a step closer in helping to create areas where the children will want to go and explore.

So far for this year we have got together and looked at ways not only to raise money but also to encourage parents to get together socially and to create fun and lasting memories for the children. The events and activities we will be working on this term are:

# Design your own Christmas Card

Due to lots of requests, 'Design your own Christmas card' will be returning this term. The teachers will be facilitating the opportunity for the children to design their own card and you will then be able to order these as well as wrapping paper, gift cards etc. yourselves online. Please remember though, once you've seen the design you must return the original piece of work to school so we can send them all to the card company – this is really important. Full information will be sent home in your child's book bags very soon.

# Christmas Pudding Competition

We have discovered a great Christmas Pudding company who also sells other puddings such as Chocolate, Lemon etc. and we will be running a competition for all the children to get involved by designing their very own Christmas Pudding label. Due to the different choices available we will be choosing the 4 best designs to appear on the puddings. This again will be facilitated by the teachers during class time. More details to follow.

## Movie Nights - 10th & 17th November

The forever popular Movie nights will be held on the 10th and 17th November. The two titles this term will be 'The Secret Life of Pets' and 'Angry Birds'. More details to follow including on how to book tickets for the children.

## Church Christmas Fayre - 26th November

This year we have been asked to help with the St Bridget's Church fayre. We will be running 4 stalls at this, all aimed at entertaining the children. We will also be organising 'Lunch with Father Christmas' and visits to his grotto on the day. We are talking to Father Christmas as we speak as he and his merry band of helpers are keen to make this event as magical as possible. We will of course be looking for extra elves on the day – more details to follow.



### Cake Sales

Our intention is to hold 2 cake sales per term, an Infant and a Junior sale. Please watch out for the posters and mentions on the PTA Facebook page and school newsletter throughout the year. For these events we always appreciate you bringing along any homemade or shop bought donations. The first Junior cake sale of this year which we held just last week raised **£192** which is a great start.

## Christmas shopping event for the children - 2nd December
